Last year it looked like the Ancaster Tennis Club was about to drop its attempts to install a long-sought dome for its facility to pro-

vide year-round games for the community.

But on a cold and windy spring day, March 25, Hamilton politicians and tennis officials celebrated a grand slam win with Rogers and Tennis Canada that

will see a dome installed this October for the club's first all-year season of tennis.

at the Ancaster facility on Lodor Street to officially celebrate the agreement with Rogers and Tennis Canada.
