WaCanld ride

The Castlegar Sunrise 2000 Rotary Club has been busy over the past two months. Typically, the summer months are a slower time for the club as members are off on holidays and enjoying the good weather, but we remained active with a number of in person meetings and events.

On August 18th the club welcomed our 2022 Rotary Scholarship recipients to an in person meeting. Here we handed out cheques in the amount of \$750 to each to Reid Gerrand, Ava Coleman, Reece Whitehead, and Daniel Buskas. It is always a pleasure to host such wonderful young adults.

Our criteria for this scholarship include career goals, volunteer work and activities in the community and at Stanley Humphries, and proof of enrollment in a post secondary program or a trade school, as well as a B average or better. If all conditions are equal, preference is given to a student active in the Rotary Interact

On August 24th and 25th the club hosted our District Governor, Linda Bauer. The Castlegar Sunrise 2000 Rotary club is one of 59 clubs within our district that covers areas from South Eastern BC, North east Washington and Northern Idaho.

On September 16th we hosted one stage of the WaCanId bike ride. This is an annual Rotarian supported, bicycle tour taking cyclists on paved roads encircling the Selkirk Mountains of Washington, Canada and Idaho. The 6-day event covers 595 kilometers and showcases the International Selkirk Loop's spectacular scenery. Members volunteered and offered support to the nearly 100 riders by providing SAG (support and gear) assistance as well as providing a luncheon at Millenium Park. Each rider pays \$695 USD to enter the ride with 70% of those fees being divided among the 9 local
